| <p>iPad Protection</p>  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To protect your child's iPad from bumps, scratches and other damage a shock proof case is required. • A tempered-glass screen protector (not plastic) is highly recommended to protect the iPad screen. • To ensure safety of iPads in school bags we suggest a waterproof zippered case to protect it from drink bottle leaks and scratches. |

Bluetooth or USB-C headphone required for 10th gen and A16 iPad and newer iPad Air and Pro models. |
