This funding will be used to

- 1 Ensure that 50% of year 3 and 5 students achieve in the upper two bands for reading and writing in NAPLAN.
- 2 By the end of 2018 70% of Prep students achieve at or above PM Level 10.
- 3 By the end of 2018 70% of year 1 students achieved at or above PM Level 19 and 80% of year 2 students achieved at or above level 25.

Our initiatives include

- 1 Provide a detailed planning process for teachers that focusses on a deep knowledge of the Australian Curriculum including reading, writing and ICT demands.
- 2 Coach and mentor teachers in best practice using the Gradual Release Methodology for reading, writing and ICT demands.
- 3 Offer intensive intervention for reading and writing.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- 1 Employ a full time Head of Curriculum to support teachers in gaining a deep knowledge of Australian Curriculum including reading, writing and ICT demands. \$90000
 - 2 Employ Head of Curriculum/Coach to unpack high yield strategies that underpin quality reading and writing practices in personalized units of work with a focus on Gradual Release Methodology.
 - 3 Employing 1 Intensive part time Reading Teacher and 2 Intensive Teacher Aides to focus on reading and writing practices. \$ 104774
