<p>iPad Protection</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To protect your child's iPad from bumps, scratches and other damage a shock proof case is required. • A screen protector is highly recommended to protect the iPad screen. • To ensure safety of iPads in school bags we suggest a waterproof zippered case to protect it from drink bottle leaks and scratches.
<p>Headphones</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students should have a set of over the head headphones (these are on class booklists). • Please check your child's iPad model for a headphone jack as some of the latest iPad models do not have one. Bluetooth headphone required for 10th gen iPad and newer iPad Air and Pro models.
<p>Other Accessories (optional)</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • An Apple pencil, Logitech Crayon or stylus can be useful additions to the iPad. These are optional.
