This funding will be used to

- 1 Ensure all teachers can demonstrate integrity when assigning A to E judgements
- 2 By the end of 2022 90 % of students achieve a C and above with 20% achieving an A in English.
- 3 Imbed inclusive practices and develop a deep understanding of the Australian curriculum, especially in English and focus e-learn pedagogy.

Our initiatives include

- 1 Provide a pedagogical support for teachers that focusses on a deep knowledge of the Australian Curriculum with an emphasis on engagement in English and 4 stages of moderation. Provide a day per term for each class teacher to develop innovative units and effective moderation processes
- 2 Coach and mentor teachers in best practice using the Inclusion Framework for thinking, reading, writing and e-learn pedagogy
- 3 Offer Intensive intervention for reading and writing using mini-Lit and Mac -Lit. Create smaller class sizes.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- 1 Head of Department to support Year Level Leaders and teams in gaining a pedagogical deep knowledge and understanding of Australian Curriculum focusing on English and ICT demands. Employ a teacher to provide NCT to cover teacher planning. \$50,000
- 2 Utilize Support Teams to unpack high yield strategies that underpin quality writing practices in inclusive units of work with a focus on deep learning. Employ an additional inclusive education teacher to support students across the school, \$120000
- 3 Employing Intensive part time Reading Teachers and Intensive Teacher Aides to focus on reading and writing practices. \$90000. Employ an additional class teacher to ensure smaller class sizes. Utilize funds from IPS {\$46105 to cover shortfall} and ISP budget.
- 4 Create a capacity building strategy to develop strong teams and a shared belief about e-learn pedagogy and a focus on teaching English.
