<p><b>iPad</b></p> 	<p><b>iPad Minimum specifications:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• iPad capable of running iPadOS 17 (iPad 6th generation and above)</li> <li>• 128GB storage (recommended)</li> <li>• Minimum 9.7 inch screen</li> <li>• Wi-Fi only – not cellular and no SIM card</li> </ul> <p><b>Complete list of supported iPads:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• iPad 6th gen</li> <li>• iPad 7th gen</li> <li>• iPad 8th gen</li> <li>• iPad 9th gen</li> <li>• iPad 10th gen</li> <li>• iPad Pro</li> <li>• iPad Air 3rd gen</li> <li>• iPad Air 4th gen</li> <li>• iPad Air 5th gen</li> </ul>
<p><b>iPad Protection</b></p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To protect your child's iPad from bumps, scratches and other damage a <b>shock proof case</b> is required.</li> <li>• A <b>screen protector</b> is highly recommended to protect the iPad screen.</li> <li>• To ensure safety of iPads in school bags we suggest a <b>waterproof zippered case</b> to protect it from drink bottle leaks and scratches.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Headphones</b></p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students should have a set of over the head headphones (these are on class booklists).</li> <li>• The iPad Air no longer has a headphone jack. Bluetooth headphone required.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Other Accessories (optional)</b></p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• An Apple pencil, Logitech Crayon or stylus can be useful additions to the iPad. These are optional.</li> </ul>
